

Local Rules

Out of Bounds (Rule 18)

Beyond any fence, hedge or wall defining the boundary of the course. On or over the boundary defined by white lines or stakes;
- Left of holes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, behind the 10th green, left of the 14th fairway, the clubhouse and its environs.

Playing Ball Provisionally

If there is doubt as to whether a ball is in, or is lost in a Penalty Area on Holes 5, 10, 12, 13 and 14, the player may play another ball provisionally under Rule 18.3 which is modified in this way:-In playing the provisional ball the player may use the stroke-and-distance relief option (see Rule 17.1d (1)) or the back-on-the-line option (see rule 17.1d (2)) or, if it is a Red Penalty Area, the lateral relief option (see Rule 17.1d (3)).
If the original ball is found outside the Penalty Area within the three minute search period, the player must continue to play with that ball.

If the original ball is found in the Penalty Area within the three minute search period, the player may either play the original ball as it lies, or continue with the ball played provisionally.

If the original ball is not found or identified within the three-minute search period or is Known or Virtually Certain to be in Penalty Area, the provisional ball becomes the player's ball in play.

Abnormal Course Conditions. (Including Immovable Obstructions). (Rule 16)

Ground under repair is defined by an area encircled by a White Line, relief without penalty (Rule 16.1b applies).

The Castle Avenue, including the iron railings, internal roads, gravel pathways, fixed signs, permanent seats, ball washers, litter baskets, the bell on 5th fairway, all fixed sprinkler heads and distance markers and artificial hole plugs on the putting greens are immovable obstructions. (Rule 16.1b applies)

Movable Obstruction (Rule 15.2)

Red and Yellow water stakes are movable obstructions. (Rule 15.2a applies)

Electrical Wires and Pylons

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line or supporting pole or wires when playing the 12th hole the stroke does not count, and the player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made. (Rule 14.6 applies).

Teeing Areas and Greens

A ball coming to rest on a Tee Box will be played as it lies. A ball coming to rest on a wrong green must be lifted and dropped in accordance with Rule 13.1f.

Bunker Faces

All grass bunker faces are deemed to be "fairway" and not part of the bunker. If ball is plugged in grass face, relief is allowed without penalty. (Rule 16.3b applies).

Competition Rules

Players entering competitions organised by the Club are advised to know and comply with the Club's Terms of Competition. Refer to notice board.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rules

Match Play – Loss of Hole. Stroke Play – Two Stroke Penalty

Etiquette Dress Code

All golfers are expected to wear appropriate Golf Attire on the Golf Course at all times whilst playing. Players are not permitted to wear on the course, Cropped Trousers, Track-Suits (Tops or Bottoms), Football sports tops of any description, Tennis/Football sports shorts, swim, beach or gym wear. (All trousers must be tailored, all shorts must be knee length, tailored)

Pace of Play

Golfers are reminded that their position on the course is immediately behind the group in front rather than immediately in front of the group behind. Please obey the Course Ranger at all times.
