•OUR SUSTAINABILITY POLICY•

At Luttrellstown Castle Resort, we understand our responsibility to the planet, our people, and the local community. As members of the Sustainable Tourism Network, we are dedicated to operating ethically and sustainably, preserving our 600-year-old estate while supporting a better future.

Our Sustainable Practices

Leadership and Engagement:

A senior member of staff has been appointed to oversee our sustainability strategy, working closely with Senior Management to ensure it remains a key priority across all operations.

Team Involvement:

- All new colleagues are introduced to our Climate Action and Sustainability policies during their orientation.
- A cross-departmental Green Team meets bi-monthly to share ideas, review progress, and promote sustainable practices across the resort.

Local and Ethical Sourcing:

We prioritise local suppliers and encourage our guests to support nearby “green” businesses and services.

Waste Management:

A robust waste management policy ensures effective segregation and recycling. We are continually monitoring and improving our waste and recycling efforts.

Reducing Carbon Emissions:

We have successfully reduced delivery traffic to the resort by 25% and introduced more electric-powered machinery to enhance air quality on the estate.

Responsible Product Use:

- Plastic toiletry bottles have been replaced with refillable or compostable alternatives.
- Guest toiletries now feature natural ingredients.
- Our kitchens exclusively use bleach-free cleaning products, with a broader resort-wide reduction planned for 2025.
- Plastic water bottles have been replaced with glass refill bottles or 100% compostable Tetra Pak alternatives.

•OUR SUSTAINABILITY POLICY•

– Sustainable Landscaping and Biodiversity:

- Our Greenkeeping team maintains the course using drought-tolerant grass species and fertilises only the playing areas.
- Over 180 trees have been planted on par 4 holes and 220 on par 5 holes.
- More than 70,000m² of lakes and 35 hectares of wild areas support diverse bird, insect, and fish populations.
- Nature's footprint is increasing due to the proximity of our surrounding woodland.

– In-House Produce:

We produce our own honey from on-site beehives, available for purchase in the Castle and Clubhouse.

– Education and Awareness:

Members of our team have completed sustainability courses with Fifty Shades Greener and Fáilte Ireland's Climate Action programme.

– Connecting with Nature:

Guests and colleagues can enjoy walking trails in our walled gardens or explore the estate using our complimentary bikes.

– Heritage and Biodiversity:

Our estate supports a thriving biodiversity programme, including a year-round herb garden, wildflower meadows, and native meadow grasses.

Looking Ahead:

- Installation of Solar Panels beside the Clubhouse (subject to planning permission).
- By 2026, we aim to implement an Energy Policy to power the resort with 100% renewable electricity and gas.
- Introduction of branded reusable takeaway cups for members, guests, and colleagues to reduce single-use waste.
